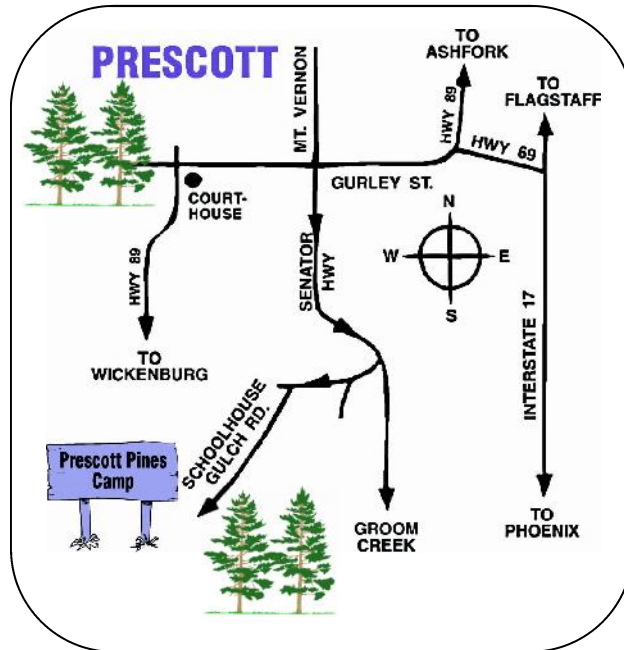

KEY INFORMATION

COST: \$200 per person (Includes 5 days, meals beginning Monday evening through breakfast on Friday morning and transportation to and from camp)

WHAT TO BRING:

- ♦ Sleeping bag and pillow (or bedding)
- ♦ Casual camp clothes (no dress-up)
- ♦ Sturdy shoes (sandals/thongs for swimming only)
- ♦ Modest swim suit (there is a heated pool)
- ♦ Toiletries, towels, wash clothes, soap
- ♦ Bible and pen
- ♦ Flashlight (*very important*)
- ♦ Lunch money for Monday on the way to camp (\$7).
- ♦ Money for snack bar. **Please do not send too much, as they often eat too many sweets and get sick.**

WHAT NOT TO BRING:

- ♦ Radios, walkmans, beepers, game boys, PSP, iPods, cell phones, etc.
- ♦ Knives, fireworks, or any item that are dangerous, illegal or questionable.
- ♦ Expensive jewelry or other articles that may get lost
